Purpose:

High school seniors graduating this year who are active members of St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church (SMMBC) are eligible to apply for a scholarship through the SMMBC General Scholarship Application. This award helps reduce the financial burden of higher education, vocational, or career training, supporting students in their academic and professional pursuits. It is designed to recognize and reward those who demonstrate a strong commitment to academic excellence and success.



Amount:

The St. Mary General Scholarship: A \$500 award for a student who has actively participated in a ministry at SMMBC.

Scholarship Requirements:

To be considered for the SMMBC scholarship, students must be actively involved in a group or ministry at SMMBC and submit the following:

- A completed and signed application
- A personal essay
- Two (2) recommendations from a current or former teacher
- unofficial high school transcript
